## **Maldives: Visas & Passports**

All foreign passengers to the Maldives must hold onward/return tickets, and the necessary travel documentation for their next destination. Furthermore, visitors entering the Maldives without a hotel reservation or a Maldivian sponsor must hold proof of sufficient funds to cover their expenses while in the country. A disembarkation card must be filled in by every passenger, and submitted to the Immigration Officer upon entry into the Maldives. Nationals of most countries can obtain a tourist visa on arrival, for a maximum stay of 30 days. Extensions of stay, to a maximum of 90 days from the date of the visitor's arrival in the Maldives, are possible, by paying a fee of MVR 750 to the Department of Immigration in Male, at least one day prior to the expiry date of the initial 30-day entry period. Note that a yellow fever vaccination certificate is required to enter the Maldives, if arriving within six days of leaving or transiting through an infected area. NOTE: It is highly recommended that your passport has at least six months validity remaining after your intended date of departure from your travel destination. Visitors without a hotel reservation should have at least USD 100 per person per day for the duration of their stay. Immigration officials often apply different rules to those stated by travel agents and official sources.

## **PASSPORT & VISA ADVICE FOR OTHER PASSPORT HOLDERS**

A valid passport is required. Please see below for notes on Visa and entry requirements. Visitors may be asked to show return or onward tickets and sufficient funds to cover their stay.

It is highly recommended to have six months' validity remaining on the travellers' passport, as border agents occasionally apply different guidelines to those stated.

### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

#### USA

US citizens must have a passport that is valid for 6 months from arrival in the Maldives. A visa is required.

#### UK

British citizens must have a passport that is valid for 6 months from the arrival date in the Maldives. A visa is required.

#### Canada

Canadian citizens must have a passport that is valid for 6 months from the arrival date in the Maldives. A visa is required.

### **South Africa**

South African citizens must have a passport that is valid for 6 months from the arrival date in the Maldives. A visa is required.

#### Ireland

Irish citizens must have a passport that is valid for 6 months from the arrival date in the Maldives. A visa is required.

#### **New Zealand**

New Zealand citizens must have a passport that is valid for 6 months from the arrival date in the Maldives. A visa is required.

## **United Arab Emirates: Visas & Passports**

All visitors to the United Arab Emirates must hold a passport that is valid for six months. Visitors must hold documents and confirmed tickets for their next destination and have a sponsor in the UAE to cover their stay. It is highly recommended that passports have at least six months' validity remaining after the intended date of departure from their travel destination. Immigration officials often apply different rules to those stated by travel agents and official sources.

### PASSPORT & VISA ADVICE FOR OTHER PASSPORT HOLDERS

A valid passport is required. Please see below for notes on Visa and entry requirements. Visitors may be asked to show return or onward tickets and sufficient funds to cover their stay.

It is highly recommended to have six months' validity remaining on the travellers' passport, as border agents occasionally apply different guidelines to those stated.

### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

### USA

United States citizens require a passport valid for 6 months after date of arrival. No visa is required for tourist stays under 30 days.

## UK

Passports must be valid for 6 months after date of entry. British passport holders can get a visitor's visas on arrival for a maximum of 30 days.

### Canada

Canadian passports must be valid for at least 6 months beyond the date of entry. Canadians entering the UAE as tourists must obtain an entry stamp at the port of entry. This entry stamp is free and valid for 30 days. It's renewable for a further 30 days.

### South Africa

South African nationals require a passport valid for six months from the departure date. A visa is required.

### Ireland

Irish nationals require a passport valid for six months from the departure date, and can obtain a visa on arrival for a maximum of 30 days.

### **New Zealand**

Passports must be valid for at least six months from the departure date. New Zealand nationals are eligible for a free 30-day visitor visa-on-arrival.

Passport and visa requirements can change at short notice. Travellers are advised to check entry requirements of the destination(s) that are travelling to or transiting via.

### FORCE MAJEURE:

We shall not be liable for any claims, losses, damages, costs, expenses, delays or loss of enjoyment, of any nature or kind whatsoever, resulting from events beyond our or a supplier's reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, strikes, lockouts or other labour disputes or disruptions, wars, blockades, insurrections, riots, earthquakes, weather conditions, floods or acts or restraints imposed by government authorities.

### TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:

Travel documents and tickets, joining and departure details, supplier addresses and phone contacts will be sent after receipt of final payment.

Note: Entry to another country may be refused even if the required Information and Travel Documents are valid and complete.

### **PASSPORTS/VISAS:**

A passport valid for six months beyond date of travel is required for entry into all countries. Visas may be required for certain countries; please inquire for details. Please check with your agent at time of booking if visas are still required for these or other countries. If you are not travelling on an American or Canadian passport, it is imperative that you also check visa requirements for all of the destinations you will be travelling to or transiting through. Ultimately, it is your responsibility to ensure you have the correct documentation.

#### PRICES:
